## STRATFORD CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING March 13, 2023

The Stratford City Council met in regular session on Monday, March 13, 2023, with Mayor Larry Runyan calling the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall and leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

Council members answering roll call were: Catherine Bergman, Carol Bergman, Terry Bryan, and Brian Ouverson. Council member Ht Buie was absent. Also present were Keith Leeds with Stratford Community Development Corporation (SCDC), Toni Larson, Dan Ostrem, Maddy Daniels and Kim Leeds.

City Manager Leeds reported that these were the revised valuations from the approved Senate File 181, which was signed into law by Governor Reynolds on February 20, 2023. Leeds clarified that the new law dropped Stratford's valuation a bit over five thousand dollars. It was also noted that property insurance went up seventeen percent or \$14,451.00.

Keith Leeds from Stratford Community Development Cooperation (SCDC) was present to update the council on their July 8<sup>th</sup> event and request to close Shakespeare Avenue from Tennyson Avenue to Commercial Street on July 8<sup>th</sup>. The event will begin at 10:00 am and be called "Stratford on the Loose." It will include a parade, vendor fair, carnival rides for children, games on main street, and

music in the evening. Leeds also explained that they will still be having their October 7<sup>th</sup> event but will be moving it to the park and calling it "Music in the Park."
